EXPLORING JOINT MANIFESTATIONS IN RASOPATHIES: A PROSPECTIVE SURVEY

- **Do you or your child have a RASopathy?**
- **Do you or your child have any kind of issue with your joint(s) such as pain, stiffness, weakness, deformity etc.?**
 - **Are you a current U.S resident?**

If you answered **yes** to all three of the questions listed above, you may be eligible to participate in a research study.

The purpose of this research study is to understand lived experiences of people who have a RASopathy and experience any kind of issue with their joint(s) such as pain, stiffness, weakness, deformity etc.

Participants will be asked to do the following:

- Take a confidential online survey (15 min)
- Take part in an optional one-on-one, audio- recorded virtual interview on Zoom (30 minutes).

Names and other identifying information will be requested as part of this study, but participant identities will not be disclosed.
